Overview of Release Ministries:

Our mission is offering hope, the opportunity for growth, and practical tools to effect change for teens, children, and families. Our focus is creating a culture for them that includes trust, forgiveness, and accountability. We do this by providing highly skilled and quality residential care in the context of meaningful relationships within a family-style living environment.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee daily operation of the house
- Mentor residents
- Teach life skills and model healthy family relationships
- Intentionally develop positive relationships with residents
- Interview prospective residents
- Assist residents in their pursuit of educational and vocational goals
- Maintain house finances, including balancing the budget and billing for residents
- Participate in weekly staffing meetings with the residential team
- Communicate with caseworkers, teachers, probation officers and/or therapists to coordinate the schedule and treatment of each resident
- Plan and implement programming opportunities for residents, both in the home and in the community
- Administer medication to residents as prescribed
- Assisting in crisis intervention and de-escalation
- Assisting in the development and implementation of residents' individualized treatment plans
- Other tasks as assigned

- Strong character and ability to pass extensive background checks
- Strong communication skills
- High school diploma required, Bachelor's Degree preferred
- Valid driver's license (with a clean driving record)
- Enjoys working with teenagers
